You can see all the topics raised and the frequency by which they came up in each Mass centre. They are also available on the Parish web-site. We are trying to address the concerns and questions raised already. During Lent we will be conducting a series of talks covering the most important issues you raised. After Easter we hope to be setting up opportunity for discussion and study of further aspects raised by our congregations. The major topic of how the Church faces the challenges of the modern world – the topic that was considered really important judging by the number of responses – needs careful planning but it is hoped that this can be covered by a series of events later in the year.
