YEAR OF COMMUNION 2019-2020

At the beginning of 2017, Bishop Declan wrote a pastoral letter inviting us to ponder the question: what is it to be the Church for our day and our culture? Two additional questions followed: what is God calling me to be and do as a member of the Body of Christ, the Church? What is it for me to be a Catholic today?

During the Year of Mission 2018 our focus was to reflect upon the ways in which we can grow in discipleship and so become more actively effective in our mission, especially to the poor and to those on the peripheries of society.

In our Year of Prayer 2019 we have focused on the fact that in the work of evangelisation we are entirely dependent on the gift of the Holy Spirit for which we must pray unceasingly.

As we begin our Year of Communion we will focus on a Spirituality of Communion and how we are called and saved, not as individuals but as God's people. We will build upon existing ways in which parishes collaborate and will encourage the work that has already begun.

BECOME CLOSER TO GOD

We have an opportunity this advent to increase our spiritual awareness. There will be three 'Lectio Divina' sessions on Wednesday 4th, 11th, and 18th December at 2.30 - 3.30 pm. These will be held in the Church Hall at St Margaret Mary, Coleford. They are individual sessions so you may attend just one, two or three. Everyone welcome.

GIFT AID OFFERTORY ENVELOPES

Box sets of numbered envelopes for 2020 are now available at the back of the church only for Parishioners who have already signed a Gift Aid declaration.

For those not already in the Gift Aid Scheme, have you considered Gift Aiding your Offertory contributions? If you pay UK Tax it is possible for the Church to recover the Income Tax which you have paid on the amount of your contributions. This equals an additional 25p for every £1 you have donated. You must obviously ensure that the total amount of tax which is reclaimed for your annual donations does not exceed the total amount of tax which you have paid in that year.

For those who have not signed a declaration but would like to use a box, a limited quantity with unnumbered envelopes is also available. Please do not use old numbered envelopes from previous years as this causes confusion at the counting and can lead to difficulties in recording the correct amount for Tax refund claims.
