Parish Information

Welcome to the Catholic Church in the Forest of Dean District. We currently have three active churches in the Forest of Dean area. They are in the towns of Coleford – St Margaret Mary, Cinderford – Our Lady of Victories and Lydney – St Joseph's. Our parish priest Father Barnabas Page is based in Coleford and as well as the churches in the Forest he is responsible for the adjacent Parish of Newent and Blaisdon.

The Mass times are available on the table below but should be checked via the newsletter or website as they do vary. Currently the Saturday vigil Mass is at 6pm and alternates between Lydney and Coleford. Sunday Mass is at 9am at Cinderford and 11am at Newent. We welcome new parishioners to the area and would be very grateful if you would fill in the form giving your contact details so that they can be added to our parish register. Please let us know if you would like to use your skills to assist in any area by ticking or adding to the list on the back page. All help is gratefully received and an excellent way to get to know other parishioners.

Why do we have a Parish Registration Form?

It's important that we have a record of parishioners who regularly attend Mass here and regard this to be their Parish. It helps us to stay in touch and use information for pastoral needs, as well as assisting us in defining who a Parishioner is, in canonical terms. This is important when it comes to administering sacraments and for diocesan and parish bureaucracy. It also means that every now and then we may notice that a Parishioner has stopped attending Mass and allows us to act quickly should something be wrong. Perhaps they have moved away or gone to another Parish but perhaps they are sick. Sometimes we discover after the event that a Parishioner was sick, and they would have liked someone to come and see them, but we had no contact details to check they were okay.

Is my information kept safe?

Yes, we comply with GDPR (General Data Protection Regulations). We have carried out a legitimate interest assessment (LIA) and the lawful basis for processing data on which we rely are consent and legitimate interest. Our Data Controller is the Chair of the Parish Council, Pip Deave and our Data Processor is Sam Buchanan, Personal Assistant to Fr Barnabas.
