On Saturday 6th July at St Bernadette's Secondary School we held our Diocesan Day Hope Does Not Disappoint.

Canon Chris Thomas, the General Secretary for the Catholic Bishops' Conference of England & Wales, was our main speaker, focusing on Hope. Phil McCarthy, a member of our own diocesan family, spoke on pilgrimage – he has developed walking pilgrimages in most of the dioceses of England and Wales, including our own from Clifton Cathedral to Glastonbury https://www.pilgrimways.org.uk/.

In the afternoon the attendees went into groups with other members of their Pastoral Area to plan a Jubilee Celebration in 2025 for their own communities and shared their specific plans during the plenary assembly. These plans are the first steps in celebrating the jubilee in Clifton diocese in our different pastoral area communities.
